WEARING POPPIES WITH NAVAL UNIFORM


NZBR 3 – Article 0212. Wearing of Poppies with Naval Uniform

• Anzac Day 2018 highlighted the inconsistency of positioning of Poppies on RNZN uniform. The below table details the current NZBR 3 Policy and includes imagery to confirm placement. RNZN, RNZNR, RNZNVR and NZCF Sea Cadet personnel are to adhere to this policy.

Garment	Position
Black Service Dress Jacket	Officers/Senior Rates/ Musicians: Over the left lapel buttonhole or an equivalent positioning. Junior Rates: Secured to the left breast of the Jacket above any medals or an equivalent positioning.


White Tunic / Bush Jacket	Above the left pocket or an equivalent positioning.
	If an individual wears Medals, Medal Ribbons or a Qualification Badge then the poppy is to be positioned centrally above all badges and medals.






White SD/ Tropical Shirt

Above the left pocket or an equivalent positioning. If an individual wears Medals, Medal Ribbons or a Qualification Badge then the poppy is to be positioned centrally above all badges and medals.
